The Oregon Lacrosse Officials Association (OLOA) made a one year agreement with Oregon High School Lacrosse Association (OHSLA) in late 2016 regards to Game Fee and Travel Fee for the 2017 Season.

### **GAME FEE**

The table below outlines the agreed upon game fee rates for the 2017 season.

Oregon HS LAX Game	Fee per Official
JV Game Fee	\$51.97
L2 Varsity Game Fee	\$60.11
L2S Varsity Game Fee	\$72.16

**NOTE:** Three officials are assigned to Varsity level. Two officials are assigned to JV level, but one official may be assigned at a rate of 1.5 the “per official fee”.

### **TRAVEL Compensation**

There is InterZone Travel and Out-Of-Zone Travel. InterZone Travel is an official living in the same Zone as the Game is being played in. (Example: Portland official working a Portland game or Eugene official working a Eugene game. Out-of-Zone Travel is an official living in a different Zone than the Zone the game is being played in. (Example: Salem official working a Portland game or a Bend official working a Burns game.

**InterZone Travel** are at the following rates by Zone:

Inter-zone payment for Bend area teams and officials - \$14

Inter-zone payment for Portland area teams and officials - \$10

Inter-zone payment for Wilsonville area teams and officials - \$10

Inter-zone payment for Salem area teams and officials - \$9

Inter-zone payment for Eugene area teams and officials - \$9

Inter-zone payment for Medford area teams and officials - \$9

**Out-Of-Zone Travel** is now based on .35/mile (roundtrip miles) from Official’s Home Zone to Game Zone.
