



## OHSLA Board Member Selection

- This could be a community leader that understands the role youth sports plays in developing people of Character, they do not need specific lacrosse experience

Our preference is to avoid active engagements with any singular program, but we are a small community. Such connections are not disqualifying, but they will take additional review.

Candidates can be nominated anonymously or may self-nominate. A short application will be available on the OHSLA webpage.

Board Meetings are the second Wednesday of each month. Each Board members is expected to be actively engaged through email throughout. While there are no set roles, we are currently looking for Members who can support the following initiatives

1. Driving the success of the youth lacrosse experience and creating seamless transitions to High School lacrosse
2. Developing and implementing a growth strategy in new areas of the state
3. Developing and managing a robust system of communication with stakeholders
