

Accessing the US Lacrosse On-line Rules Exams

This document will walk you through accessing the US Lacrosse Annual Rules Exams for certification as an official.

You will first need to start on the US Lacrosse Central Hub for Officials on Arbitersports that you should have access to as a US Lacrosse member here: www.uslacrosse.arbitersports.com.

1. You will need to login to your Arbitersports account in order to access the exam.
 - Please note – you must login using the email address associated with your US Lacrosse Membership
