RE: 2022 OLOA Vaccination Status Requirements

Dear Member Officials-

The Oregon Lacrosse Officials Association (OLOA) and Oregon High School Lacrosse (OHSLA) have jointly agreed to the following policies for the 2022 Oregon high school lacrosse season:

- All OLOA member officials will be vaccinated for the COVID-19 virus in order to be considered for game assignment(s) during the 2022 Oregon high school lacrosse season - **zero exceptions will be granted in 2022.**
- All officials will be required to be vaccinated for COVID-19 and have received their second vaccine dose, effective a minimum of two weeks (14 days) prior to opening day, occurring on March 14, 2022. Accepted vaccination must originate from one of the following companies: Moderna, Pfizer, or Johnson & Johnson.
- Proof of vaccination status is required to be digitally submitted to the OLOA, via the provided confidential "Vaccination Portal" member link (emailed from Secretary Kyle Virding). These digital submissions must be completed by February 28, 2022, to be included in the first round of game assignments.
- Two OLOA Board members will be privy to reviewing the COVID-19 vaccination documentation submitted by the membership - President Hoffert & Secretary Virding. Hoffert & Virding are tasked with confirming the validity of documentation and troubleshooting any issues which occur during vaccine status submissions from the membership.
- President Hoffert partners with Commissioner Schlesinger and the OHSLA Board of Directors to share any new and/or changes to League policy regarding vaccination status of OLOA member officials.
- The OHSLA and the OLOA Boards of Directors both reserve the right to make changes or adjustments to the 2022 OLOA Vaccine Status Requirements, as necessary to reflect city/county/state/federal health authority guidelines and mandates. NOTE: As of 02/22/22, "booster vaccine shots" are not actively required, but certainly encouraged - this is subject to OHSLA/OLOA change.
